Legal information and rules for participation in the Mitsubishi Elbe meeting

Article 1 – General liability issues

I/We participate in the event and its offerings at my/our own risk and voluntarily.

By participating, I/we irrevocably waive any right to take action against instructors, organization, site owners and organizers for all accidents and damages arising in connection with this event (see also Article 3).

As the vehicle owner, I am personally liable – both for my own vehicle, which I use to attend the meeting, and for any damage caused to other vehicles or property as a result of my actions or the actions of the accompanying persons travelling in my vehicle.

The undersigned confirms with his/her signature that he/she has taken note of the contents of this waiver of liability and to have expressly acknowledged this. Parents are liable for their children. All games aimed specifically at children do not include any childcare offered by the organizer. Children must never be left unsupervised at any time !

Article 2 – Road Traffic Law

As a participant, I am subject to the generally applicable traffic regulations both on the grounds and during activities outside the event area. Participation in the event does not exempt me from the applicable regulations of the StVO, StVZO or FZV. Drivers who take part in the night rally or the car parade are required to take part in the driver briefings provided for this purpose.

Article 3 – Harmful events, criminal offences and other misdemeanours

All legal regulations of our society (criminal law, criminal procedure code, civil law, rights of all citizens) are also binding within the event grounds. Should damage to vehicles or property occur, the parties to the damage will settle this among themselves. This disclaimer of liability releases the organizer from any liability in the event of damage that is not caused by his actions or work. If events are of criminal relevance, the organizer will call the police and regulatory authorities for help and work closely with the responsible authorities to clarify the situation. In these cases, the personal data of affected participants will be made available to the investigating authorities. The results of the investigation into a criminal or civil matter can lead to disciplinary consequences for the person responsible, including on the part of the organizer. The organizer has the right to refuse entry to the venue. Special specific rules for interaction may apply here. The organizer's ORGA team is authorized to give instructions within the event area. ORGA members can show their ID.

Article 4 – Medical care

The organizer informs all participants about emergency measures before and during the event. A small contingent of medication and bandages will be kept at the entrance to ensure first aid. Emergency numbers will be announced.

Article 5 – Legal framework of the event

The event has been registered with all relevant local authorities. The responsible regulatory authority is the Bad Schmiedeberg town council and the Wittenberg police headquarters. These and other authorities may carry out checks during the event (e.g. health department, police checks, public order office). The employees of these control bodies and their instructions must be fully followed after they have identified themselves as such. They are authorized to give instructions beyond the event law.

Article 6 – Image rights, image liability and data protection

By signing this document, the participant agrees to the following in case of winning a trophy or a non-cash prize: to be available for some winner photos after the award ceremony, which will serve as proof to our sponsors and dissemination via the media.

The organizer undertakes to publish the personal data transmitted to him by the participant only partially and within the scope of the necessary requirements on the web (e.g. registration list for the event, winners list after the event). The passing on of the data received from participants to third parties (e.g. advertising companies, market research) is completely excluded.

Article 7 – Services (electricity, water, sewage)

Event guests do not pay extra for the use of electricity and water (showers, toilets). These services are already included in the posted participation fees. Participants must bring their own functioning and trouble-free power supply and are responsible for using it. The supply of electricity is finite and depends on the available, unfortunately limited, capacity. The toilets can be used 24 hours a day, and showers are available between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. Wastewater containers carried in mobile homes and trailers must not be disposed of on or in the vicinity of the Elbe meeting (drinking water protection zone)!

Article 8 - Animals

Animals brought along to the event must be kept on a leash or in a cage that prevents the animal from escaping, but also protects it from unauthorized access. The animal must not be left unattended at any time. For certain breeds of dog, the special regulations for Saxony-Anhalt apply (e.g. fighting dogs). The owner is solely responsible for taking care of the animal. The organizer is exempt from any responsibility. If assistance is required, everything necessary can be requested at the entrance.

Article 9 – Disturbance of the peace, acoustics, night-time rest

From 11 p.m. onwards, every participant must ensure that the noise from the event is kept to a level that is tolerable for the residents. After 11 p.m., only the DJ will make noise or play loud music. In the interests of good relations with the residents of the host town, revving the engine or loud music systems should be avoided, even outside the venue.

Article 10 – Code of Conduct

If you notice that one of your friends or family members has or is having problems with other guests, you are required to de-escalate the conflict. In conflict situations, try to defuse the atmosphere and separate the parties in dispute. Calm down participants you know and ensure that the situation is resolved without injury or aggression. Many participants do not like it when their vehicles are simply touched, touched or otherwise appropriated by others. In individual cases, this may also include taking photos of the vehicles. Please consider the wishes of the vehicle owner, especially if this is expressed to you. If you are unsure how and whether you can take action on someone else's vehicle, try to find the owner and ask them beforehand if necessary. Remember that other people will constantly see you at the event and your behavior will be judged accordingly. Personal habits should only be lived out in a way that does not offend other guests. This applies in particular to the cleanliness of the area you use. The organizer provides options for waste disposal - please use them! Before leaving the Elbe meeting, we ask you to leave the area you used for your club or vehicles as clean as you found it when you arrived.

Article 11 - Final Declaration

Only correctly and completely filled out participation declarations from the organizer, whether downloaded in advance or directly at the Tickets issued for admission entitle you to participate in the event. Please read the rules carefully - by signing, you acknowledge that you will behave within these general conditions at the event. If you refuse to sign, you will not be able to participate.
